General Summary of Previous Twelve Months
For Annual Meeting
March 12, 2024

The following is a partial list of actions completed by the Town Board and other workers and volunteers in 2023:

- Continued expansion and clean-up of the cemetery including new survey and mapping
- Improved recreation areas around Town Hall
 - Resurfaced and converted tennis courts into one multi-sport court and 3 pickleball courts and
 - Added goals/nets on the ball field
 - Removed diseased trees
- Replaced Town Hall furnace
- Conducted one election (township)
- Published 5 newsletters
- Revitalized and improved township web site
- Completed approximately 0.3 miles of chip seal and fog seal road preservation on portions of Lakeview Avenue
- Rebuilt and resurfaced approximately 0.6 miles of Sevastopol Road and Lakeview Avenue
- Broadened shoulders along several public roads; performed weed control and spraying as needed
- Cleared trees and limbs blocking roads and trail as needed, mostly with volunteer labor
- Repaired damaged sections of Rattlesnake Bluff Trail; expanded edge mowing for safety
- Contracted with a professional firm to conduct upkeep on ditches along Wacouta Road and Lakeview Avenue
- Installed road signs along Lakeview Avenue, Grace Trail, Wacouta Road and Sevastopol Road
- Initiated policy development for Cemetery use and Airbnb oversight

Planned

- Continue chip sealing as funds permit
- Continue weed/noxious species control
- Conduct crack-filling on Rattlesnake Bluff Trail
- Conduct 4 elections (local, state, federal primary and general)
